1. Winter Maintenance on UW Madison Campus – E. Agnew

- Provided a map of campus showing the division of labor with PP Grounds and PP Custodial Units.
 - An area from Campus Lakeshore Bike Path to North of University Ave, Highland Ave to Park St and East Campus Mall and North of Engineering Dr.
 - 15 miles of streets
 - 60 miles of sidewalk
 - 100 bus stops
 - Contract with Daniels when there is more than 1” of snow.
 - Snow relocated from the garages and surface lots to outside of Goodman Diamond.
 - Salting practices include using a brine mixture and less rock salt.
 - Equipment calibrated annually.

3. Director's Report: P. Kass

- **Linden Garage Project Presentation**
 - Goes before the Board of Regents in February 2019
 - Out for bid summer 2019
 - Construction begins fall 2019
- **Lot 129/130 Presentation**
 - Architect submitted design packet and is currently under review.
 - Construction scheduled to begin summer 2019.
- **Campus Bus Study – D. Ward**
 - Partnership with UW Housing and ASM
 - Captured Nelson-Nygaard Campus Bus and Accessible Transportation study 2012, UW Campus Master Plan 2015 and KA Associated Campus Bus Study 2018.
 - Transportation Services 2018 recommendations for further study:

- Reduce crowding on Route 80
 - Add 1-2 buses to Route 80 loop
 - Create a limited stop “ski lift” route up Bascom Hill
 - Add articulated buses
 - Investigate adding capacity in winter
 - Improve travel times to south campus
 - Add a south campus circulator route
 - Re-evaluate number of buses going to Eagle Heights
 - Change Route 80 4-3 bus split to a 2-5 split
 - OR
 - Two-way Route 84 all day for standard weekday service instead of Route 80 long route AND/OR
 - Investigate adding capacity in winter
 - Timeline:
 - Renew ASM MOU
 - Discuss concepts with ASM
 - Begin reviewing concepts with Metro
 - Administer a student preference survey
 - Fall 2018-Spring 2019
 - If funding partners agree, add vehicles to current Route 80
 - Solidify larger service change proposal
 - Present proposal to campus for feedback (website, forums, focus groups)
 - Make revisions based on feedback
 - Fall 2019 - Proceed through city public meeting requirements and any related revisions
 - Spring 2020 - Implement larger service changes
