 - FY23 Budget Updates
 - Presented FY23 budget with a 1% rate increase.
 - Changes to the Flex parking program
 - Continue with the reduce cost permit program
 - Reviewed revenue increases
 - Reviewed increase in overall salary expenses as TS hiring a number of vacant positions and adding some new positions.
 - Increase in operating expenses due to surface lot and parking facility repairs
 - Increase in campus bus and employee bus pass expenses
 - Overall projecting a half million-dollar deficit as the budget stands right now
- **Commuter Solutions Update: Dar Ward**
 - Closing the UW Hospital Park and Ride Lot 203 in fall 2022
 - Preparing for upcoming parking year with lots of communication through emails and TS website to educate the flex customers on the changes for the fall.
 - Solar Bus Shelter - hoping to install in July
