## Night Parking Weekdays after 4:30 p.m. + weekends

### Night surface parking permit\*\*

- \$133 per parking year (Sept. 1 Aug. 31): prorated
- Valid weekdays from 4:30 p.m. to 7 a.m. and all day Saturday & Sunday in Lots 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 16, 18, 21, 30, 33, 44, 51, 81, 85, 91, and 92

#### Night garage parking permit\*\*

- \$46 per parking year (Sept. 1 Aug. 31), prorated
- Valid for parking in one specific garage only: Lot 6, 7, 17, 20, 23, 27, 29, 36, 38, 46, 67, 76, 80, 83, or 95
- Valid in assigned garage on weekdays from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m. and all day Saturday & Sunday
- \*\* Afternoon and night permits are not valid during posted special events.

# UW Hospital Parking Weekday afternoons, nights, weekends

#### Lot 75 afternoon parking permit

- \$325 per parking year (Sept. 1 Aug. 31), prorated
- Valid for parking in Lot 75 only on weekdays from 2 p.m. to 8 a.m. and all day Saturday & Sunday

#### Lot 75 night garage parking permit

- \$56 per parking year (Sept. 1 Aug 31.), prorated
- Valid for parking in Lot 75 only on weekdays from 4:30 p.m. to 8 a.m. and all day Saturday & Sunday

#### **Madison Metro Transit**

Madison Metro bus routes provide service to the UW campus. A fare or a bus pass is required to ride Metro Transit city routes. Schedules and maps are available at mymetrobus.com.

All Metro Transit buses are wheelchair accessible. Supplemental Metro Transit paratransit service is available weekdays from 5:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m.

### **Employee bus pass**

Eligible UW employees can purchase an employee bus pass for unlimited rides on Madison Metro city buses.

Employee bus passes cost \$48. Bus passes are prorated after Sept. 1. UW Health employees get their passes reimbursed by their employer.

### Purchase a permit or bus pass

Purchase at a Transportation Services office, or use your NetID or UW Health credentials to purchase afternoon/night parking permits and bus passes online at transportation.wisc.edu/ebusiness.

#### **Terms and conditions**

Parking permit and employee bus pass holders must follow UW-Madison Transportation Services policies. Failure to follow these policies may result in revoked parking privileges. For a list of policies, visit transportation.wisc.edu/rates-and-policies.

### Campus parking rules

- Transportation Services has the right to reserve parking lots for special events. Lots reserved for an event will be posted at the lot entrance and/or on the Transportation Services website.
- Vehicles are not allowed to park in fire lanes, reserved stalls, surface lot motorcycle stalls, service/vendor stalls, loading zones, construction areas, sidewalks, disabled access aisles, driveways, or grass areas.
- Transportation Services has the authority to close a lot for construction, maintenance or safety issues. Permit holders will be notified in advance of lot closures whenever possible. Permit holders may be relocated at any time.
