## 2. Transportation Services Reports & Updates

- Assistant Vice Chancellor Updates: Patrick Kass, Assistant Vice Chancellor
  - FY24 Parking Rates & Program Changes
  - o 1% increase for the following TS products:
    - Park and Ride
    - Annual Base Lot Permits
    - Motorcycle and Moped Permits
    - Departmental Limited, Service and Vendor Permits
    - Business Alternate
    - Afternoon Permits
    - Reduced Cost Permits
    - Semester Permits
    - E-Scooter Permits
  - No increase for Bus Pass, Night Permits, Monthly Permits or Visitor Parking
  - Reasons why only 1% increase:
    - Increase in permit demands
    - Costs have dropped
    - Cost savings in positions that are vacant for FY23
    - Capital projects have pushed back/postponed
    - Small increase is needed to cover increasing cost of maintenance for campus parking structures.
  - Reduce cost permits are currently available for employees making =< \$38,168 or \$\$18.35 or less an hour
  - Looking at increasing the reduce cost permit threshold. Currently in discussions with campus leadership. Will have an update at the February meeting which will require a vote.

#### Commuter Solutions Updates –Dar Ward, Commuter Solutions Manager

- 2023 Biennial Survey out February 2, 2023, which is a random sampling of mode choices to access campus.
- o Response to the survey help Transportation Service understand how campus community members travel to campus and shape the future of the UW-Madison transportation system.
- Survey will be offered for 6 weeks
- o Results will be presented at the May 19, 2023 CTC Meeting
- Changes for the survey include
  - Previously sent out to three separate groups, now combined into one group
  - Revised to plain language standards
  - Translated into the 5 languages used on campus
  - Survey was translated by CLA for no cost
