2. Transportation Services Reports & Updates

- Construction Update: Rob Kennedy, Transportation Planner
 - March 11-19, 2023, Walnut Street closed both ways to repair damaged railroad bridge
 - No changes to the Bakke and Vet Med schedules
 - CDIS temporary walkway for bikes and pedestrians
 - Working with TS GIS specialist for new summer construction maps. Will bring to the March Meeting.

• Assistant Vice Chancellor Updates: Patrick Kass, Assistant Vice Chancellor

- FY24 Parking Rates & Program Changes
 - 1% increase for annual base lot rates: Park and Ride, Annual Base Lot Permits, Motorcycle and Moped Permits, Departmental Limited, Service and Vendor Permits, Business Alternate, Afternoon Permits, Reduced Cost Permits, Semester Permits, E-Scooter Permits
 - No increase for Bus Pass, Night Permits, Monthly Permits or Visitor Parking
- Two questions for the committee to discuss:
 - Leave reduced cost permit threshold as it is today [Reduce cost permits are currently available for employees making =< \$38,168 or \$18.35 or less an hour] or
 - Raise the reduced cost permit threshold to \$42,500 which would include another 90 people to be eligible for this program.

- Discussion: To continue the reduced cost permit program and index it with the state raise which would increase the threshold to \$38,931.00. Agreed to the 1% rate increase as discussed in the January 27 CTC meeting.
- MOTION: Maintain the reduced cost permit program to include a 2% increase to eligibility threshold to account for the 2% state raise increase; also increase annual permit rates by 1% made by Alex Franks and seconded by Diane Mayerfeld.
