Reduced cost parking permit program

At the request of campus administration, UW Transportation Services <u>created reduced and low-cost product options</u> during the 2020-21 parking year for certain lower wage-earning employee groups.

These offerings were originally intended only for the 2020-21 parking year and were continued through the 2021-22 parking year. The program expanded in the 2022-23 parking year and continued through 2023-24. The existing program will be extended through 2024-25.
