

Shuttle stops and schedule

Lot 206 permit holders can ride a free shuttle weekdays from approx. 5:40 a.m. to 7:57 p.m., except on UW state-observed holidays when on-campus parking will be available instead:

Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, and Independence Day

Shuttles run **every 20 minutes** at peak times and **every 30 minutes** at off-peak times.

Times are approximate. The shuttle schedule is subject to delays due to construction, weather, heavy traffic, or other factors.

Please note: Lot 206 shares several stops with the Lot 202 shuttle. Make sure to get on the right shuttle to return to Lot 206!

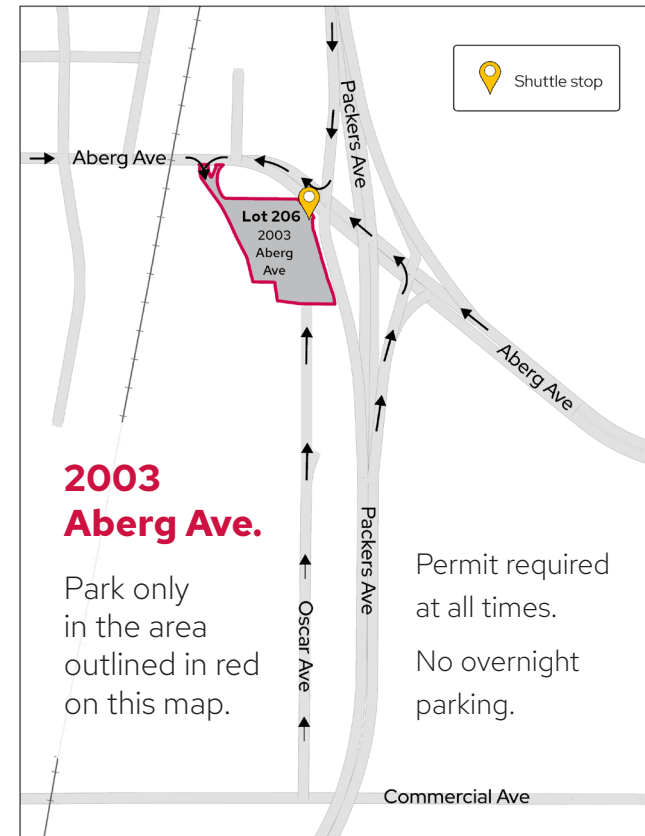

Lot 206 (Aberg & Packers) Park and Ride

UW-Madison park and ride permits are a low-cost option for employees to park in an off-campus lot and use alternative forms of transportation to arrive on the UW campus.

Park and ride Lot 206 is served by a shuttle with designated stops across the campus. Permit holders can also bike, walk, carpool, or ride Metro Transit to campus.



After-hours on campus

Your Lot 206 permit allows you to park on the UW campus during off-peak hours!

Display your park and ride permit during these times to park in any “yellow” lot where UW permits are required:

Weekdays 4:30 p.m. to 7 a.m.

All day Saturday and Sunday

(except in lots closed for construction or reserved for a special event)

You may also park during off-peak hours in “green” lots where no permit is required.

Weekday parking on campus

Options for parking on campus on weekdays during peak hours (7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.):

- Half-day and daily permits can be purchased up to one week in advance from any Transportation Services office.
- Pull a ticket and pay by the hour at a UW campus garages where public parking is available. Check map.wisc.edu for locations.

Emergency Ride Home

You are eligible for the Emergency Ride Home program (ERH), which provides a cab ride from campus to your home or vehicle in case of an emergency. For details, visit:

Commuting tips

The shuttle is one of many ways to complete your journey to campus. You can also supplement your commute with Metro Transit bus service, campus bus service, or bicycling.

Madison Metro Transit

Eligible employees may purchase a bus pass starting August 1 for \$48. (Cost is prorated by date of purchase.) The pass is valid each year from September 1 through August 31.



UW and UW Medical School employees may order an employee bus pass online at transportation.wisc.edu/ebusiness.

UWHC and UW Medical Foundation employees are not charged for employee bus passes: UWHC covers 100% of the cost for employees.

Bicycling



Ride by bicycle between 206 and campus. The trip is approx. 4-6½ miles and 25-40 minutes depending on the campus location. Check [Google Maps](https://www.google.com/maps) for your best route, which may include Sherman Avenue, E. Mifflin Street, State Street, and others.
