 - **Approved:** Passed voice vote with 1 abstention

2. Transportation Services Reports & Updates

• Assistant Vice Chancellor Updates: Patrick Kass, Assistant Vice Chancellor

- CTC members are invited to participate in the Director of Parking Operations Interviews-2 candidates
 - Invites went out to committee members and other stakeholders for Tuesday, September 24 and Wednesday, September 25 to be held in room 132 WARF
- 4.5% increase in demand for parking this year over last year
- Opened a new Park and Ride lot at the Oscar Mayer plant on the east side of Madison
 - Currently have sold around 100 of the 300 spaces available
- Park Street park and ride is sold out and has a waitlist
- Old UW Credit Union, 3500 University Ave- we are currently selling monthly permits while leasing some of the space to UW Hospital through the end of the year
- Who We Are and What We Do Presentation – PowerPoint will be sent out to the committee with the minutes. Highlights below:
 - Major Duties includes but not limited to Permit Management, Parking Enforcement, Special Event Parking, Travel Reduction management, Campus Mobility, Employee and Student Bus Pass Program, Bicycling & Pedestrian Support, Visitor Parking, Traffic Planning, Mope management, Parking Lot Maintenance, Outreach and Education, Camus Fleet, Maintenance Garage and Student SAFEwalk Program.
 - Transportation Services employs over 200+ employees across 3 shifts 24/7 operations
 - Customers=anyone who access the campus
 - Transportation Services Role with the University
 - Budget: Where does the money come from and how is the money spent
 - Review of program changes over the years going back to 2013
 - Upcoming projects, Lakeshore Path Alternative, Campus Drive Bike Path Extension, Frances Street Garage Concept, Dayton Street Garage, Spring Street Garage, Children’s Hospital Garage Expansion, and Lake Street garage Redevelopment.

- **Commuter Solutions Updates – Gabe Mendez, Commuter Solutions Manager**
 - BRT officially starts on Sunday, September 22, 2024
 - Transportation Services took over the distribution and sales of ASM bus passes
 - Sold over 30,000 bus passes
 - 25,000 bus passes have been distributed to date
 - Oscar Mayer Park and Ride is up and running but currently does not have bike racks
 - New campus map will be available on TS website Monday, September 23, 2024
